

THE KAPLAN FAMILY HOSPICE HOUSE



The Hospice House in Danvers is a twelve patient hospice facility created for the Hospice of the North Shore. It is a home for terminally ill people who seek the sense of comfort that only a home can provide. The patient rooms have sunrooms, sitting areas and outdoor patios. Other amenities include a country kitchen with a dining room, living rooms, children play areas, a library and a chapel/meditation room overlooking a healing garden in the courtyard. The Hospice House also contains a center for grief and healing where families can receive assistance in dealing with the loss of their loved ones. The design is characterized as a grouping of small buildings connected together which resembles a small village utilizing local architectural symbology.
